

David Wilkie Scholarship for the Study of Spanish Art

The Centro de Estudios Europa Hispánica and the University of Edinburgh are delighted to announce the creation of a fully-funded doctoral scholarship in Spanish art-historical studies, commencing in the academic year 2017/18. The scholarship will cover the University Home/EU/International tuition fees for three years (or four if required), together with an annual stipend of £14,000 for living costs and travel.

The scholarship supports research on Spanish art including its reception by British artists, collectors, and critics. Proposals relating to the period between the late 17th and the 20th century are particularly welcome.

Applications should be submitted to the University of Edinburgh online postgraduate application system (History of Art) by **1 February**. For further details, applicants are advised to contact the Postgraduate Office well before the deadline: ecaresearchdegrees@ed.ac.uk.
