

Nigel Glendinning Doctoral Studentship in Spanish Studies

King's College, Cambridge announces the Nigel Glendinning Doctoral Studentship in Spanish Studies: Art and Literature of 17th and 18th century Spain. Funding is available for a three- to four- year course of study, commencing in academic year 2019/2020. Candidates must apply to the University of Cambridge to study either at the Department of History of Art, the Department of Spanish and Portuguese (Faculty of Modern and Medieval Languages), or the Faculty of History and must put King's College, Cambridge as their first-choice college. The successful candidate will be selected by the College.

Candidates are encouraged to apply to the appropriate department or faculty by 8 February 2019.

Funding will be sufficient to cover tuition, fees and maintenance costs, plus an annual allowance for research and travel.
