In this seminar, organised in connection with the exhibition *Visionary Romantics*. *Balke, Lucas, Hertervig* and the publication of its accompanying catalogue, academics and curators will analyse how these Romantic artists – two of them Norwegian and one Spanish – despite having no contact, practised almost simultaneously a type of landscape painting that stemmed more from their inner visions than from faithful imitation of nature.

As members of an international trend based on the aesthetic ideal of the sublime, Balke, Hertervig, and Lucas used experimental or uncommon techniques to disintegrate and manipulate forms, capturing innovative mental landscapes that to an extent foreshadowed the loose manner of Impressionism and other modern painting movements. This experimental techniques align them with 19th-century landscapists such as Caspar David Friedrich, J. M. W. Turner, and Victor Hugo.

The <u>exhibition</u>, curated by Knut Ljøgodt by Carlos Sánchez Díez with the assistance of Inger M. L. Gudmundson, features over sixty works including paintings, watercolours, and drawings from the Museo Lázaro Galdiano, the Stavanger Art Museum, and The Gundersen Collection (Oslo).

The <u>catalogue</u>, edited by the curators with contributions by Spanish and Norwegian scholars, is available both in Spanish and English.
